Storage duration	<p>The data you enter during the registration process will be deleted three months after the end of the event. Photographs taken for the external presentation will be deleted in accordance with the statutory retention periods or in the event of a revocation/right of objection.</p>
Right of objection according to Art. 21 DSGVO	<p>You also have the right, for reasons related to your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of personal data concerning you, which is carried out according to Art. 6 Abs.1 lit. e) or f) DSGVO. We will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove to have compelling reasons for the processing worthy of protection which outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or the processing serves the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.</p>
